

If the student is 17 or younger, the online health form must be completed by a PARENT, but the student may assist his or her parent in completing the form. If the student is 18 or over, the student may complete the form on his or her own.

1. Please go to → aylhealth.com
2. Create an account by clicking on the **“Create an Account”** link. Be sure to write your username and password and keep it in a safe place where you will be able to access it. You may need this information again in the future!
3. Follow the instructions and complete the information on the **“Make a New Account”** screen that will appear. Please note you must enter a **PARENT’S name**, *not* the name of the camper. Click **“Register”** when you are done.
4. The next screen will say “My Health Forms.” Click on the **“Create New Form”** button.
 - ▶ If you see a request for “Registrant ID” and “Access Code,” you can skip that by clicking on the blue button on the top that says “Don’t have a registrant id?”
5. A pop-up window will appear asking you to create a signature. **THE NAME OF THE PARENT MUST BE ENTERED IN THIS BOX!** (*Your child’s name must NOT be used as the signature!*) When finished, click the blue button that says, **“Use this signature on the following pages.”**
6. The health form will then appear. If needed, enter your **CHILD’S** first and last names in the appropriate boxes as the “Camper/ Guest.”
7. For **“Home Area,”** click on the link that says, **“Select Young Life Area.”** A pop-up window *may* appear that asks for your permission to know your current location. We recommend that you do **NOT** allow the website to “know” your current location because where you live may overlap with other Young Life areas, thus leading to confusion. Instead, after choosing NOT to share your current information, you will see a box that says, “Enter Area Number.” In that box, enter **“NJ68”** and then the words “NJ68 - Asian Young Life” should appear (*It may take a few seconds for “NJ68 - Asian Young Life” to appear. Please be patient.*). Click on **“NJ68 - Asian Young Life,”** and then click the **“Select”** box. Do NOT enter a Zip Code! (*Many people accidentally select “Bergen County”; please do NOT select Bergen County! Make sure it says, “NJ68 - Asian Young Life.”*)
8. Where it says “Camp,” select **Saranac Village**. For “Guest type,” select **Camper**. And for “Select a camp session/week,” select **7/31/2023 - 8/5/2023**. After doing this, click **“Save and Continue”** (or *“Finish Later”* if you do not have time right now).
9. Continue completing ALL 9 pages of the health form, and please pay attention to any alerts or highlighted sections that still need to be completed.
10. Wherever you see a blue “Sign” button, simply *click* the blue **“Sign”** button, and your signature will appear.

Important Info for Page 4 - Health Care History

For this section, you **MUST** upload an official immunization record, which must show two doses of measles, mumps, and rubella vaccinations. To upload, please scan a copy of your child’s immunization record or take a picture of it. (*You can skip this information for now by checking the option, “Applicant will bring a paper immunization record.” But please note we **MUST** have the paper copy before the child boards the bus. Your child will not be permitted to attend camp without this document.*) You do NOT have to upload your child’s COVID vaccination card in this form.

Info for Page 5 - Health Care Recommendations

Please enter the name and phone number of your family physician. Also be sure to answer Questions 1, 2, and 3 on this page. Please note that for *most* students, the answers to Questions 1 and 2 in this section should be “No” (*unless your child does, in fact, have a medical concern, in which case you should select “Yes”*). If your child is taking medication, click “Yes” to “Is the applicant taking any medications or under any treatments that need to be continued at camp?” If this applies, please list the medications and dosages.
