Departure Information - Friday, March 13, 2026

Thank you for being a pioneer with us on our first-ever Harvesters Weekend! We will be traveling to Lake Champion in a school bus provided by Aldin Transportation. We will depart from **East Bergen Christian Church, 320 Beverly Rd, Teaneck, NJ 07666** on **Friday, March 13 at 4:30 PM.**

We will stop for dinner on the way to Lake Champion, so please bring money for dinner.

Packing List

Please do NOT overpack. Please put your belongings in a duffel bag, backpack, or anything that is flexible. We will be traveling in a school bus, so there will not be too much space for luggage.

Clothing

- hoodie/sweatshirt
- athletic clothing for the gym/game room (e.g., gym shorts, sweat pants, T-shirts)
- swimsuit (for the optional hot tub)
- pajamas (or whatever you wear to sleep)
- underwear and socks for 3 days
- closed-toe shoes (like sneakers)
- flip flops (for showering)
- appropriate jacket for March weather (The temperature will be in the **low 40's** at Lake Champion, so pack accordingly!)

Toiletries

- toothbrush
- toothpaste
- soap/bodywash
- shampoo
- deodorant
- contact lenses
- contact lens case
- contact lens solution
- extra contact lenses
- eyeglasses
- skincare and other toiletries
- feminine products (for girls only)

Miscellaneous

- Bible, pen, and a notebook/journal
- \$30+ for food on the way to and from camp
- spending money for the camp snack bar/store (The camp accepts cash, credit cards, and Apple Pay.)
- water bottle (to stay hydrated)
- laundry/plastic bag (for dirty clothes)
- beach towel
- if you take medicine, please bring it

You do NOT have to bring a shower towel, bed pillow, bed linens, or a sleeping bag. These will be provided at Lake Champion. Evening temperatures will be in the **low 40's**, so you may want to bring an extra blanket from home to keep warm at night.

We will return to East Bergen Christian Church in Teaneck on Sunday, March 15, around 3:00 PM.

Policies

- If you develop COVID or have any other illnesses like a cold or the flu on the day of our departure, we ask you to stay home. Please TXT/call us at **(201) 777-0-AYL** (0295) if you are sick.
- We are committed to fostering a safe environment in which **ALL** participants are treated with respect and dignity. Inappropriate behavior like hazing or pranking, which embarrasses and humiliates others, undermines this principle and is strictly prohibited and will not be tolerated under any circumstances. Engaging in such behavior will result in immediate disciplinary action, including dismissal from camp.

- Absolutely **NO** alcohol, e-cigarettes/juul, hookah, or illegal drugs are permitted. You won't need drugs or alcohol to have fun this weekend! If you bring such items to camp, we will notify your parents, who will be asked to take you home.
